Fertilizer prices have doubled in the past two years, but proper fertility is essential for the high crop yields in Iowa. This workshop is designed to provide timely topics for farmers looking to find ways to work together utilizing either liquid or dry manure as a nutrient resource. The workshop will cover a spreadsheet on how to convert fertilizer prices to manure test equivalent so that buyers and sellers have a good starting point on what the value is now and where it might be in the future and information on what to test for when selling manure and typical agreements that are required if the manure comes from a site that requires a manure management plan, for both liquid and dry manure.

Buying and Selling Manure workshop will be taught by Kapil Arora, Field Agricultural Engineer, Kelvin Leibold, Farm Management Field Specialist, and Russ Euken, Livestock Specialist.
